Dear Members and Customers,

This is to inform you of a potential crisis in Anderson and surrounding counties regarding our/your water supply. There are two companies, Redtown Ranch, LLC and Pine Bliss LLC (different LLC's) that have filed applications with the Neches Trinity Valleys Groundwater Conservation District (NTVGCD), requesting permits to drill twenty-one (21) commercial wells in south Anderson County and also a number of wells in Henderson County. They have applied for permits to pump in excess of fifteen billion (15,000,000,000) gallons of water on an annual basis.

Brushy Creek WSC is opposed to these projects and will be filing a protest with the Neches Trinity Valleys Groundwater Conservation District. You as a member and property owner in Anderson or Henderson County also have the opportunity to file a protest regarding this matter, if you choose to do so.

Please take the time to educate yourself on this matter. It is a very serious and could have long term implications for our counties water supply. Brushy Creek WSC pulls from the Carrizo and Wilcox aquifers.

Enclosed is an example of a template to file a protest. This must be received by the NTVGCD **before 11:00 am on June 19th, 2025**. You can either email, mail, or deliver in person to the NTVGCD.
